Formatting Guidelines for Technical Paper

- 1. Paper should be an MSWord document.
- 2. All the authors should be included in the cover page.
- 3. Title and Heading should be in Bold, Times New Roman and font size 14.
- 4. Abstract should be no more than 200 words.
- 5. Table of Contents should list the Tables, Figures, References and Appendix.
- 6. Paragraphs should be indented.
- 7. Double line spacing between paragraphs.
- 8. Text of the paper should be in Times New Roman, size 12 and single line spacing.
- 9. Full justification should be used.
- 10. Page numbering should be at the bottom of the page and centered.
- 11. Table numbers should be sequential and end with a period. Example: Table 1. Table 2.
- 12. Table numbers should be in bold and left aligned.
- 13. Table headings and the content of the table should be justified.
- 14. Label rows and columns should have borders.
- 15. Equation numbers should be sequential.
- 16. Figures should be in black and white.
- 17. Figure numbers should be sequential and end with a period. Example: Figure 1.
- 18. Figure title should be in bold and left aligned.
- 19. Graph legend should have a box.
- 20. Notes or any Source data should appear below the tables and below the figures.
- 21. References should precede Appendix.
- 22. Appendix heading should be in Times New Roman and size 14.
- 23. Bibliography format: First Author (Last name) (Initials), and Second Author (Initials) (Last name). "Title of the Paper." Name of the Journal. (Year):Page Number.
